- IIV accreditation is up for renewal. We have started the process by completing a self-assessment (9 categories with 46 practices to be evidenced). Volunteer Now have appointed an advisor, George Gillespe who has arranged a training session with staff on Monday 8th April.
- The extent to which we meet the criteria in the self-assessment will form the basis of a development plan. One key change is that we no longer have a Volunteer rep on the board.
